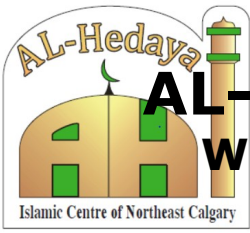

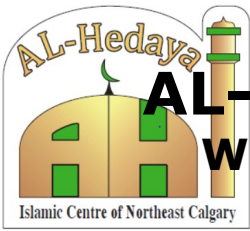

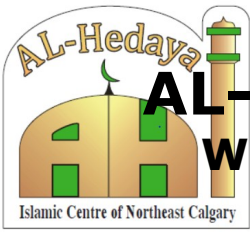

All course content will be delivered through lecture, discussion, critical thinking, assignments and activities.

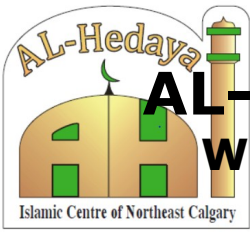
Student Learning Outcomes

- All assignments and projects should be completed on time and are a compulsory part of the course. One Major Project per grade will account for 10% of the final exam marks.



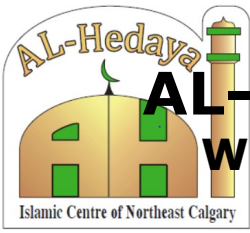

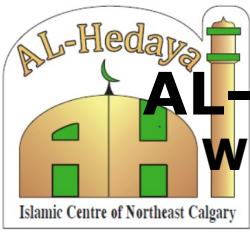
